Coronavirus (Covid-19) Addendum

1. The School is open for face-to-face classes, in a classroom.
2. Students are required to comply with the School rules to prevent the spread of the virus and UK laws relating to Coronavirus and infectious diseases.
3. Our Homestay providers are required to comply with Coronavirus policies and procedures for Homestays, which are based on regulations and guidelines from of the UK Government and sets out the additional requirements to prevent the spread of the virus, how to monitor the situation, and what to do if the student or a family member develops symptoms.
4. If any student develops symptoms of Covid-19 (temperature, cough, loss of taste and/or smell, body aches), the student should stay at home and avoid contact with others. The student should test themselves and return to School only if the test is negative.
5. If the test result is positive for Covid-19, the student must not come to School for at least 5 days, which is when people are most contagious. Students cannot return to School until they have a negative test result.
6. If there is a positive case of Covid-19 in a student's household with, the student must get tested and return to School only if the test is negative.
7. In order to protect students and staff, especially the most vulnerable, the School reserves the right to ask the student to leave the building if they display any Covid-19 symptoms (see above).
8. In the event that during the course of the studies, a student tests positive for Covid-19, is required to isolate, and is unable to join classes, the student can defer up to 2 weeks of classes of the same value to a later date and within 12 months of the absence start date.
9. Should the student prolong their stay due to Covid-19 isolation, quarantine, or deferral, the student will be liable for the additional costs of accommodation, travel changes (including flights), and any other associated cost incurred as a result.
